## Who are we?

## Your challenge?

The challenges of access to essential services are based on technical aspects, but also on institutional and socio-economic aspects. National companies and/or technical service n cities face internal organisational challenges in ensuring quality service to the population. National authorities, for their part, are responsible for ensuring that a conducive framework and



environment exist. The expectations of populations and their ability/willingness to pay for a service are also issues that local or national entities must understand in order to develop relevant and sustainable policies, strategies and concrete actions.

Working alongside Bruno Valfrey, Head of Innovation, Research and Knowledge (IRS), you will be in close contact with the entire group team, particularly the experts responsible for institutional and socio-economic issues. You will support them in the deployment of methodologies and the analysis of data collected in the field, and you may also be asked to participate in national or local workshops that will enable you to understand how strategic documents and roadmaps are developed in the water, sanitation, waste and energy sectors.

More specifically, your duties will revolve around three main activities:

- **Participation in ongoing projects:**
  - o Bibliographic analysis and drafting of summary notes
  - o Analysis of stakeholders and stakeholder dynamics: participation in the drafting of organisational and institutional assessments
  - o Supporting the organisation of and participating in sectoral workshops: logistical support with our local partners, organisational management, participation in facilitation, note-taking.
  - o Support for the evaluation of international cooperation programmes (country strategy, thematic analyses, etc.)
- **Support for commercial activity:** responding to expressions of interest and calls for tenders, core methodological expertise in consulting:
  - o Support for **the development of relevant methodologies** to propose these approaches in our responses to calls for tenders
  - o **Search for partners and new talent**
  - o Support for the **formatting, drafting and technical feasibility** of proposals.
- **Support for the group's ongoing capitalisation process** on the theme

## You are the person we need if:

- You are completing a Master's degree or equivalent with training in development economics, public policy in southern countries, or political science
- You have a strong appetite for development projects; prior knowledge of issues related to essential services and the institutional aspects of their deployment will be considered an advantage
- You have very good analytical and writing skills
- You have one or more previous experiences in developing countries. These would be a significant asset in the consideration of your application
- You have a very good command of French and English, both written and spoken; proficiency in another language (Spanish, Portuguese, Arabic) will be considered an asset
- You have an appetite for innovation and skills transfer
- You have a sense of organisation and attention to detail, enabling you to work in a team on a variety of tasks in a small organisation.



- You have a cheerful disposition and a sense of humour, making teamwork enjoyable
- You are willing, if necessary, to carry out assignments in emerging or developing countries as part of the projects you will be involved in .
